



Important update:

- **Inspection Day – Monday 11th May 2020 (by appointment)**
- **Autumn Bull Sale – Monday 18th May 2020**

Taking into consideration the current COVID-19 circumstances, we are pleased to clarify our bull sale on Monday 18th May 2020 will still take place. The following protocols, recommended by ALPA must be adhered to:

- **COVID-19 declaration must be completed** by all attending;
 - You can find a copy of this declaration on our website in the 'Sale Information' section. We will also have copies available on sale day for you to complete.
 - The declaration includes:
 - *Have you travelled internationally in the last 14 days?*
 - *Have you been in close contact with a person who has travelled internationally in the last 14 days?*
 - *Have you been in contact with a person diagnosed with coronavirus in the last 14 days?*
 - *Have you within the previous 72 hours, experienced flu like symptoms?*
 - *Are you feeling unwell now?*
- **Attendance:** only genuine buyers with a true intention to purchase must attend, plus essential staff including accredited livestock agents.
- **Practice social distancing:** please ensure you are 1.5 metres apart, with no more than 2 people gathering at any one time.
- **Utilise hand washing facilities:** we will have hand sanitiser available on sale day.
- **Pre-inspection by appointment** is recommended. Our inspection day is on Monday 11th May. Please contact Bill (0428 245 208) or Tom (0422 050 019) to arrange an appointment.
- **Auctions Plus:** You are encouraged where possible to utilise Auctions Plus, phone bidding or to place an order with your Livestock Agent.
 - **Reminder:** if you are intending to operate over Auctions Plus and are not already registered, this must be completed 24 hours prior to sale.
